Hanson Canada's Scholarship Guidelines

"Be awarded up to \$2,000 in Scholarships"

Scholarships provided by Cambrian at Hanson & City of Maple Financial, ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 will be awarded to eligible Hanson students.

How to Participate:

Fill out the Hanson Scholarship Application Form which is available in the Student Services department. For Hanson students, you must complete the form and submit it to the academic department at the Toronto, Brampton, or Vancouver campus. For Cambrian College's Barrydowne students, please inquire about scholarship submission with the International Department office.

Scholarship application forms can be submitted starting on September 12, 2016 and the deadline for submission is Friday October 14, 2016.

Selection Criteria:

Scholarships will be awarded to the selected Cambrian at Hanson students and Cambrian College Barrydowne Campus international students aged 18 years or older; to be considered for the scholarship, students must be enrolled in their second, third, or fourth semester, on a full time basis.

Principal's Scholarship of Distinction recognizes outstanding students who are able to maintain an overall GPA of 4.0 and are also active participants in college events and are actively involved in the community.

Scholarship of Distinction is awarded to students who maintain an overall GPA of 3.7 and who actively participate in college events as well as show commitment outside of the academics.

Scholarship of Excellence is given to students who are able to maintain an overall GPA of 3.5 and show most improvement in their commitment to academics as well as participation in college events.

To be eligible for the scholarships, the students must fulfill the following criteria:

1. Student Characteristics: Students who have demonstrated the following characteristics:
 - A. *Citizenship*: Students who follow class behaviour expectations and policies - they show up to every class, show up on time, leave when excused by their teacher, and never disrupt the class with cell phone use or talking with other students.
 - B. *Most Improved*: Students who have shown a notable increase in following the class behaviour expectations and policies and who have shown a significant increase in their GPA.

- C. *Participation:* Students who participate in college school activities and who participate in, and contribute to, their classes in a positive manner.
 - D. *Academics:* Students who have demonstrated a high GPA throughout their school program.
2. Students must not have any history of late or incomplete tuition payments according to the college's tuition fee policies;
 3. Students must not have a history of class attendance below 85%;
 4. Students must obtain one reference either from administrative staff or a faculty member;

Students acknowledge and agree to comply with the following when they submit a scholarship application:

- A committee will review the applications that meet the selection criteria;
- The awarding of scholarships for Hanson's students will be decided by a Hanson scholarship selection committee and the awarding of scholarships for Cambrian's Barrydowne students will be decided by Cambrian's administration; all decisions are final;
- Any person applying for the scholarship agrees to accept the conditions and rules of the application and selection process and understands that the applicant is subject to applicable laws;
- Each winner authorizes Hanson or Cambrian College to use his/her name and photograph for publicity purposes without remuneration;
- Cambrian at Hanson reserves the right to end the scholarship, adjust the amounts, and/or modify its conditions from time to time;
- Scholarship recipients will each be given a T4A form in February of the following year for income tax purposes.

Application instructions:

1. Read the Selection Criteria to determine your eligibility.
2. Complete the Hanson Scholarship Application Form. Please be careful; incomplete forms will not be considered.
3. Ask one of your instructors to complete a Faculty Reference Form for you. **The instructors already have this form.** The instructor will make comments and rate criteria such as your attendance, participation, leadership, commitment, integrity, and helpfulness.
4. Your instructor will return the completed Faculty Reference Form directly to the Academic Department. You will not see the completed form.
5. Give your completed Hanson Scholarship Application Form to the Academic Department. **The deadline for submission is Friday, October 14, 2016.**
