Scholarship Guidelines

Be awarded up to \$2,000 in Scholarships!

Scholarships range from \$500 to \$2,000 and will be awarded to eligible Cambrian at Hanson students.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

HANSON students must complete the form and submit it to the Academic Department at your respective campus. Scholarship application forms can be submitted started on **Monday, March 19th, 2018** and the deadline for submission is **Friday, April 13th, 2018**.

Please note that students cannot win the same scholarship award twice.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Scholarships will be awarded to the selected Cambrian at Hanson international students aged 18 years or older. Please note that graduating students (on their last semester for their program of study) are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate.

Scholarship of Excellence

This scholarship is awarded to students who have shown a GPA for 4.0 for the current semester; who are active in school events; and who have good conduct (no incident reports). Selection will be based on a draw of students who meet the criteria by the Scholarship Committee.

Overall Achiever

This scholarship is awarded to students who have shown a GPA for 4.0 for the current semester; who are active in school events; and who have good conduct (no incident reports). Selection will be based on a vote by Faculty.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Read the Selection Criteria and Eligibility Requirements to determine your eligibility.
- Complete the Hanson Scholarship Application Form. **Incomplete forms will not be considered.**
- Complete and attach to your application your 500-word response.
- Ask TWO (2) of your instructors to complete and submit a Faculty Reference form for you and submit it directly to the Academic Department by the deadline. **You will not see the completed form.**
- Submit your completed Hanson Scholarship Application Form to the Academic Department. **The deadline for submission is Friday, April 13th, 2018.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1) Student Characteristics

Applicants who have demonstrated the following characteristics are eligible for a scholarship:

A. Citizenship	Refers to students who demonstrate consistent and proper conduct and good behaviour, in accordance to Hanson’s class behaviour expectations, policies, and procedures. Examples: perfect attendance, NO incident reports in their student file (i.e. no cheating incident reports).
B. Participation	Refers to students who actively participate in college school activities and events, and who participate in – and contribute to – their classes in a positive manner.
C. Academic Standing	Refers to students who have a GPA of 4.0 for the current semester.

2) Good Standing in Tuition Payments

Applicants must not have any history of late or incomplete tuition payments, as according to the college’s tuition fee policies.

3) Attendance

Applicants must have a history of good attendance.

4) References

ALL applicants must obtain **two (2) reference letters** from two (2) faculty members (instructors).

STUDENT AGREEMENT AND COMPLIANCE

Students acknowledge and agree to comply with the following when they submit a scholarship application:

1. Scholarships are not guaranteed to every applicant. Only successful applicants will be contacted about their award.
2. All applicants applying for scholarships agree to accept the conditions and rules of the application and selection process and understands that the applicant is subject to applicable laws.
3. Each winner authorizes Hanson or Cambrian College to use his/her name and photograph for publicity purposes without remuneration.
4. Cambrian at Hanson reserves the right to end the scholarship, adjust the amounts, and/or modify its conditions from time to time.
5. Scholarship recipients will each be given a T4A form in February of the following year for income tax purposes.
